

Beginning of Yah's Day

Genesis 8:21-22 *And Yah smelled a soothing fragrance, and Yah said in His heart, "Never again shall I curse the ground because of man, although the inclination of man's heart is evil from his youth, and never again strike all living creatures, as I have done, as long as the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease."*

Genesis 32:26 *And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I'm not letting You go until You have blessed me!"*

Exodus 2:18 *And they came to Re'u'el their father, and he said, "How is it that you have come so soon today?"*

Exodus 10:4 *Or else, if you refuse to let My people go, see, tomorrow I am bringing locusts within your borders.*

Exodus 10:13 *And Mosheh (Moses) stretched out his rod over the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), and Yah brought an east wind on the land all that day and all that night. Morning came, and the east wind brought the locusts.*

Exodus 17:9-12 *And Mosheh said to Yehoshua, "Choose for us men and go out, fight with Amaleq. Tomorrow I am stationing myself on the top of the hill with the rod of Yahuah in my hand. And Yehoshua did as Mosheh said to him, to fight with Amaleq. And Mosheh, Aharon, and Hur went up to the top of the hill. And it came to be, when Mosheh held up his hand, that Yisra'el prevailed. And when he let down his hand, Amaleq prevailed. But Mosheh's hands were heavy, so they took a stone*

and put it under him, and he sat on it. And Aharon and Hur supported his hands, one on one side, and the other on the other side. And his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

Exodus 18:13 *And it came to be, on the next day, that Mosheh sat to rightly rule the people. And the people stood before Mosheh from morning until evening.*

Exodus 24:18 *And Mosheh went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And it came to be that Mosheh was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.*

Exodus 32:5-6 *And Aharon saw and built a slaughter-place before it. And Aharon called out and said, "Tomorrow is a festival to Yahuah." And they rose early on the next day, and offered ascending offerings, and brought peace offerings. And the people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.*

Leviticus 6:20 *This is the offering of Aaron and his sons, which they bring near to Yahuah, beginning on the day when he is anointed: one-tenth of an ephah of fine flour as a daily grain offering, half of it in the morning and half of it in the evening.*

Leviticus 7:15 *As for the flesh of the slaughtering of his peace offerings for thanksgiving, it is eaten the same day it is offered, he does not leave any of it until morning.*

Leviticus 8:35 *"And stay at the door of the Tent of Appointment day and night for seven days. And you shall guard the duty of Yahuah, and not die, for so I have been commanded."*

Leviticus 22:30 *“It is eaten that same day, leave none of it till morning. I am Yah.”*

Numbers 16:4-7 *And when Mosheh (Moses) heard, he fell on his face, and spoke to Qorah (Korah) and all his company, saying, “Tomorrow morning Yahuah shall make known who is His and who is set-apart, and bring him near to Him. And let Him bring near to Him the one whom He chooses. Do this: Take fire holders, Qorah and all your company and put fire in them and put incense in them before Yahuah tomorrow. And it shall be that the one who Yahuah chooses is the set-apart one. Enough of you, sons of Lewi (Levi)!”*

Deuteronomy 10:10 *And I stayed in the mountain for forty days and forty nights. And Yah heard me at that time also, and Yah chose not to destroy you.*

Deuteronomy 21:23 *Let His body not remain overnight on the tree, for you shall certainly bury Him the same day – for He who is hanged is accursed of Yah – so that you do not defile the land which Yah your Elohim (God) is giving you as an inheritance.*

Judges 19:9 *And the man arose to go, he and his concubine and his servant. But his father-in-law, the young woman’s father, said to him, “See the day is now drawing toward evening. Please spend the night. See, the day is coming to an end. Stay here, and let your heart be glad. And you shall rise early tomorrow for your journey, and you shall go to your tent.”*

1st Samuel 11:9-11 *And they said to the messengers who came, “Say this to the men of Yabesh Gilad (Jabesh-Gilead). ‘Tomorrow, by the time the sun is hot, you shall have help.’ “Then the messengers came and informed the men of Yabesh, and they rejoiced. So the men of Yabesh*

said, “Tomorrow we come out to you, and you shall do to us whatever seems good to you.” And it came to be, on the next day, that Sha’ul (Saul) put the people in three companies. And they came into the midst of the camp in the morning watch and struck Ammon until the heat of the day. And it came to be that those left were scattered, so that no two of them were left together.

1st Samuel 19:11 *And Sha’ul (Saul) sent messengers to Dawid’s (David’s) house to watch him and to put him to death in the morning. And Mikal (Michal), Dawid’s wife, informed him, saying, “If you do not save your life tonight, tomorrow you are put to death.”*

1st Kings 8:59-60 *And let these words of mine, with which I have made supplication before Yah, be near Yah our Elohim day and night, to maintain the cause of His servant and the cause of His people Yisrael (Israel) the matter of each day in its day, so that all the peoples of the earth might know that Yah is Elohim, there is no one else.*

Isaiah 4:5 *Then Yah shall create above every dwelling place of Mount Tsiyon (Zion), and above her gatherings, a cloud and smoke by day and shining of a flaming fire by night, for over all the esteem shall be a covering.*

Jeremiah 7:25 *From the day that your fathers came out of the land of Mitsrayim until this day, I have even sent to you all My servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending them.*

Jeremiah 33:20-21 *“Thus said Yahuah, ‘If you could break My covenant with the day and My covenant with the night, so that there be not day and night in their season, then My covenant could also be broken with Dawid My servant – so that he shall not have a son to reign upon his throne and with the Lewites, the priests, My attendants.*

Jonah 4:7 *But as morning dawned the next day Yah appointed a worm which struck the plant so that it withered.*

Psalms 42:8 *By day Yahuah commands His loving-commitment, and by night His song is with me.*

Psalms 92:2 *To declare Your loving-commitment each night, and Your trustworthiness each night.*

Matthew 27:45 *And from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land, until the ninth hour.*

Matthew 28:1 *But late in the Sabbath, as it was dawning into day one of the week, Miryam (Mary) from Magdala and the other Miryam came to see the tomb.*

Mark 4:35 *And on the same day, when evening had come, He said to them, "Let us pass over to the other side."*

Mark 14:30 *And Yahusha said to him, "Truly I say to you that today, this night, before the cock shall crow twice, you shall deny Me three times."*

Mark 15:42 *And when evening had come, because it was the Preparation Day, that is, the day before the Sabbath.*

Mark 16:1-2 *And when the Sabbath was past, Miryam from Magdala, and Miryam the mother of Ya'aqob (Jacob) and Shelomah brought spices, to go and anoint Him. And very early on day one of the week, they came to the tomb when the sun had risen.*

Luke 23:44-45 *And it was now about the sixth hour, and darkness came over all the land, until the ninth hour. And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the Dwelling Place was torn in two.*

Luke 24:1-2 *But on day one of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and they found the stone rolled away from the tomb.*

John 1:39 *He said to them “Come and see.” They went and saw where He was staying, and remained with Him that day. Now it was about the tenth hour.*

John 1:43 *On the following day Yahusha wished to go to Galil (Galilee), and He found Philip (Phillip) and said to him, “Follow me”.*

John 4:6-8 *And Ya’aqob’s (Jacob’s) fountain was there. So Yahusha, being wearied from the journey, was sitting thus at the fountain. It was about the tenth hour. A woman of Shomeron came to draw water, Yahusha said to her, “Give Me to drink.” For His taught ones had gone off into the city to buy food.*

John 6:16-22 *And when evening came, His taught ones went down to the sea, and entering into the boat, they were going over the sea toward Kephah Nahum (Capernaum). And it had already become dark, and Yahusha had not yet come to them. And the sea was rising because a great wind was blowing. When they had rowed about twenty-five or thirty stadia (miles), they saw Yahusha walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were afraid. And He said to them, “It is I, do not be afraid.” They wished therefore to take Him into the boat, and at once the boat was at the land where they were going. On the next day, the crowd that was standing on the other side of the sea saw that there was no other boat there except that one into which His taught ones had entered, and that Yahusha had not entered the boat with His taught ones, but His*

taught ones went away alone.

John 20:1 *And on day one of the week Miryam from Magala came early to the tomb, while it was still dark, and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb.*

John 20:19 *When therefore it was evening on that day, day one of the week, and when the doors were shut where the taught ones met, for fear of the Yehudim (Jews), Yahusha came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace to you."*

Acts 2:15 *For these men are not drunk, as you imagine, since it is only the third hour of the day.*

Acts 4:3-5 *And they arrested them, and put them in jail until the next day, for it was already evening. But many of those who had heard the word believed, and the number of the men became about five thousand. And it came to be, on the next day, that the rulers and elders and scribes assembled in Yerushalayim (Jerusalem).*

Acts 10:3-10 *He clearly saw in a vision, about the ninth hour of the day, a messenger of Elohim coming to him, and saying to him "Cornelius!" And looking intently at him and becoming afraid, he said, "What is it, master?" And he said to him, "your prayers and your kind deeds have come up for a remembrance before Elohim. "And now send men to Yahpho (Joppa), and send for Shim'on who is also called Kepha. He is staying with Shim'on, a leather-tanner whose house is by the sea." And when the messenger who spoke to him went away, Cornelius called two of his household servants, and a dedicated soldier from among those who waited on him continually. And having explained to them all, he sent them to Yapho. And on the next day, as they were on their way and approaching the city, Kepha went up on the house-top to pray, about the sixth hour. And he became hungry and wished to eat....*

Acts 20:7 *And on day one of the week, the taught ones having gathered together to break bread, Sha'ul intending to depart the next day, was reasoning with them and was extending the word till midnight.*

Acts 20:11 *Then going up again, and having broken bread and eaten, he talked a long while, even till daybreak, and so went forth.*

Romans 13:12 *The night is far advanced, the day has come near. So let us put off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light.*

2 Peter 1:19-21 *And we have the prophetic word made more certain, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts, knowing this first, that no prophecy of Scripture came to be of one's own interpretation, for prophecy never came by the desire of man, but of Yahuah spoke, being moved by the Set-apart Spirit.*

Revelation 4:8 *And the four living creatures, each having six wings, were covered with eyes around and within. And they do not cease day or night, saying "Set-apart, set-apart, set-apart, Yahuah El Shaddai, who was, and who is, and who is coming!"*

Revelation 7:15 *"Because of this they are before the throne of Yahuah, and serve Him day and night in His Dwelling Place. And He who sits on the throne shall spread His Tent over them."*

Revelation 8:12 *"And the fourth messenger sounded, and a third of the sun was struck, and a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. And a third of the day did not shine, and likewise the night."*

Revelation 12:10 *And I heard a loud voice saying in the heaven, “Now have come the deliverance and the power and the reign of our Yahuah and the authority of His Messiah, for the accuser of our brothers, who accused them before our Yahuah day and night, has been thrown down.”*
