

**Genesis 4:9-11** *And Yahuah (God) said to Qayin (Cain), “Where is your brother?” And he said, “I do not know. Am I my brother’s guard?” And He said, “What have you done?” The voice of your brother’s blood cries out to Me from the ground. **And now you are cursed from the earth**, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother’s blood from your hand.*

**Genesis 4:17-19** *And Qayin (Cain) knew his wife, and she conceived and bore Hanok (Enoch). And he built a city, and called the name of the city after the name of his son Hanok. And to Hanok was born Irad. And Irad brought forth Mehuya’el (Mehujael), and Mehuya’el brought forth Methusa’el (Methusael), and Methusa’el brought forth Lemek (Lamech). And Lemek took for himself **two wives**, the name of one was Adah, and the name of the second was Tsillah (Zillah).*

**Genesis 4:23-26** *And Lemek said to his wives, “Adah and Tsillah, hear my voice! Wives of Lemek, listen to my words! For I have killed a man for wounding me even a young man for hurting me. **“For Qayin is avenged sevenfold, and Lemek seventy-sevenfold.”** And Adam knew his wife again, and she bore a son and called his name Sheth (Seth). “For Yahuah has appointed me another seed instead of Hebel (Abel), because **Qayin had killed him.**” And to Sheth, to him also a son was born. And he called his name Enosh (Enos). **Then it was begun to call on the Name of Yahuah.***

**Genesis 5:5** *So all the days that Adam lived were **nine-hundred and thirty years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:8** *So all the days of Seth were **nine-hundred and twelve years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:11** *So all the days of Enosh were **nine-hundred and five years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:14** *So all the days of Qeynan (Cainan) were **nine-hundred and ten years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:17** *So all the days of Mahalal'el (Mahalaleel) were **eight-hundred and ninety-five years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:20** *So all the days of Yered (Jared) were **nine-hundred and sixty-two years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:27** *So all the days of Methushelah (Methuselah) were **nine-hundred and sixty-nine years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 5:28-29** *And Lemek lived one hundred and eighty-two years, and brought forth a son, and called his name Noah, saying **"This one does comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which Yahuah has cursed."***

**Genesis 5:31** *So all the days of Lemek were **seven-hundred and seventy-seven years**, and he died.*

**Genesis 6:1-5** *And it came to be, when men began to increase on the face of the earth and daughters were born to them, that the sons of Yahuah saw the daughters of men, that they were good. **And they took wives for themselves of all who they chose.** And Yahuah said, **"My Spirit shall not strive with man forever in his going astray. He is flesh, and his days shall be one-hundred and twenty years."** The **Nephilim** (Giants) were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of Yahuah came in to the daughters of men and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, the men of name. And Yahuah saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was **only evil** continually.*

**Genesis 6:8-13** *But Noah found favor in the eyes of Yahuah. This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with Yahuah. And Noah brought forth three sons: Shem, Ham, and Yapheth (Japheth). And the earth was corrupt before Yahuah, and the earth was filled with violence, and Yahuah looked upon the earth and saw that it was corrupt – for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth – and Yahuah said to Noah, “The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence through them. And see, I am going to destroy them from the earth.*

**Genesis 6:18** *“And I shall establish My Covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark, you and your sons and your wife and your sons’ wives with you.*

**Genesis 7:1** *And Yahuah said to Noah, “Come into the ark, you and all your household, because I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation.*

**Genesis 7:13** *On that same day Noah and Shem and Ham and Yepheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah’s wife and the three wives of his sons with them, went into the ark...*

**Genesis 9:24-25** *And Noah awoke from his wine, and he knew what his younger son (Ham) had done to him, and he said, “Cursed is Kena’an (Canaan), let him become a servant of servants to his brothers.” (Noah lived 950 years)*

**Genesis 10:6-9** *And the sons of Ham: Kush (Cush), and Mitsrayim (Mizraim), and Put, and Kena’an (Canaan). And the sons of Kush: Seba, and Hawilah (Havilah), and Sabtah, and Ra’mah (Raamah), and Sabteka (Sabtecha). And the sons of Ra’mah (Raamah): Sheba and Dedan. And Kush brought forth Nimrod, he began to be a mighty one of the earth. He was a*

*mighty hunter before Yahuah, therefore it is said, “Like Nimrod the mighty hunter before Yahuah.”*

**Genesis 10:18** ...*And afterward the clans of the Kena'anites (Canaanites) were spread abroad.*

**Genesis 10:32** *These were the clans of the sons of Noah, according to their generations, in their nations. And from these the nations were divided on the earth after the flood.*

*(After tower of babel, Peleg lived only 209 years and his son Re'u lived 207 years, Terah lived 205 years. Shem lived 600 years, Arpakshad lived 438 years, Peleg lived 239 years, Re'u lived 239 years Serug lived 230 years, Nahor lived 148 years, Terah lived 275 years and brought forth Abram, Nahor, and Haran.)*

**Genesis 16:5** *And Sarai said to Abram, “My wrong be upon you! I gave my female servant into your bosom. And when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her eyes. Let Yahuah judge between you and me.”*
